AREAS OF LEARNING

As AuthorsWe will explore a variety of animal themed stories , we will write labels, lists and captions for our work and pictures, we will write poems using our senses, we will write recounts following a trip to the zoo.

As Mathematicians...we will learn to recognise numbers to 20 and beyond, add small numbers by counting on, recognise coins and find out totals, tell the time to the hour, use measures, begin to use subtraction, understand odd and even numbers and order days of the week

As Scientists....we will identify, compare and name animals, we will explore where animals live, what they eat and how they live. We will name basic body parts both human and animal. Biology unit)

As Historians...we will look at how humans and animals have changed since they were babies

As **Geographers**....we will use globes and maps to find out where the UK and Amazon Rainforest is. We will make comparisons between the rainforest and Leek.

As **Musicians**....we will explore the sounds of the rainforest. We will listen to, play along to and learn a Reggae song.

As **Artists**....we will create observational drawings and painting of ourselves and animals. We will look at the painting 'Tiger in the Storm' by Rousseau and recreate artwork inspired by his work
