## CONFIDENT INDIVIDUALS

### SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL

We will make friends and become confident in our new classroom (PSED) through 'Good Morning time'.

We will talk and listen to each other (CL). We will model good listening through circle time.

### POSSIBILITIES

We will offer a range of opportunities to look at a variety of real heroes such as nurse, doctor, firefighter and police and the job that they do.

We will encourage the children to think of ways that they could be a 'real hero'.

### CREATIVITY

We will make our learning environment a welcoming place which is personal to us by painting, making collages and creating artwork to display. We will encourage the children to take pride in their creations. We will enjoy making music and singing songs.

## RESPONSIBLE CITIZENS

### COMMUNITY

As members of a community we will visit our local church, bring in harvest food gifts for people in our community and participate in our Harvest Festival.

### ENTERPRISE

We will learn about working to help ourselves and others. We will make bread and talk about the job of a baker and the journey from field to shop to home. We will learn about the Christian Aid Harvest appeal and the Baker in the Sudan.

### DIVERSITY

As members of a diverse culture we will learn about heroes from around the world. We will hear the stories of Mother Teresa and Ghandi. We will learn about Harvest in other countries .

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## SUCCESSFUL LEARNERS

### AREAS OF LEARNING

As **Authors** we will get ready for writing by taking part in Dough Disco and Squiggle Wiggle which helps us to develop strong muscles in our hands and fantastic pencil grips. We will read Superhero stories and have a Superhero themed day to inspire learning.

As **Mathematician** we will be investigating and naming shapes by making Superhero pictures with shape prints and making Superhero houses by cutting and sticking shapes. We will learn to count and recognise numbers using our Superhero song, Superhero themed number resources and games.

As **Scientists** we will investigate our senses by tasting, smelling and touching harvest vegetables. We will learn about the 'Superhero powers' of hot and cold by making hot toast, spreading cold butter and watching the melting process.

As **Geographers** we will imagine flying to other countries to see where our food comes from. We will learn to use a simple map to follow the 'Superhero trail' around the school.

As **Musicians** we will be singing songs, like the 'Superhero Parade' and playing musical instruments.

As **Designers** we will design superhero costumes for ourselves and decorate them with art materials. In construction we will design and build Superhero houses.

As **Artists** we will decorate our classroom, taking ownership of what we would like to see. We will create pants for Superheroes to wear and vegetable print pictures. We will create a Superhero City Wow Board to display our wow moments.

As **Computer Scientists** we will use the mouse to create Superheroes of our own using the Paint program.
