SUCCESSFUL LEARNERS

AREAS OF LEARNING

As AuthorsWe will explore a variety of toy themed stories, we will write about our own favourite toys and describe them using adjectives, we will write recounts following a trip to the toy museum.

As Mathematicians...we will learn to recognise numbers to 20 and beyond, add small numbers by counting on, recognise coins and find out totals, tell the time to the hour, use measures, begin to use subtraction, understand odd and even numbers and order days of the week.

As Scientists....we will explore seasonal changes in the winter. We will explore the different materials that toys are made from and how they work.

As Historians...we will look at how toys have changed from when our grandparents were children and visit a museum to see how children lived and what they played with over 100 years ago.

As Geographers....we will use simple fieldwork and observational skills to study the geography of our school. We will also look at toys from around the world.

As Musicians.... We will play un-tuned instruments musically/ use our voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

As Artists.... We will look at the work of Andy Warhol, in particular the prints he produced on Toys. The children will take photos in the style of Andy Warhol and also make artwork by printing toys/ doing mono-prints of toys.

As Designers We will design and makes toys using recycled materials/ moving toys using paper engineering.

As Computer Scientists...we will learn to program BEEBOT robots, we will also continue to learn how to log onto a class computer and print out our own work. We will explore different learning apps on the I-pads including the BEEBOT app.
