SUCCESSFUL LEARNERS

AREAS OF LEARNING

As AuthorsWe will explore traditional and Fairy stories such as the Three Little Pigs and Hansel and Gretel, we will also have a go at writing our own stories. We will explore non fiction texts and write poems .

As Mathematicians...we will learn to recognise numbers to 100, add and subtract two digit numbers by counting on or back and by using money, tell the time to half past the hour, partition numbers into tens and units, find $\frac{1}{2}$'s and $\frac{1}{4}$'s of shapes and quantities, work out number problems and understand basic multiplication and division.

As Scientists....we will learn about and explore the properties of different materials . We will learn about our weather here and around the world. We will design and make our own homes for the three little pigs.

As **Historians**...we will learn about houses and buildings from the past. We will also look at and explore different artefacts from around the home long ago.

As **Musicians**....we will listen to music from the Charanga music program, we will learn to use simple percussion instruments.

As **Artists**....we will create observational drawings and painting of homes, buildings and household objects from long ago . We will look at painting by Paul Klee and recreate artwork and textiles inspired by his work.

As **Designers** ... We will look at a variety of interesting architecture from around the world to help inspire us design our own buildings.

As **Computer Scientists**...we will continue to log onto a class computer and print out our own work. We will explore different learning apps on the I-pads and programs on the computer.
