Children in Nursery and Reception classes can choose whether to produce a decorated egg or an Easter Bonnet.



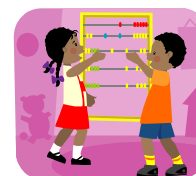
Leek Rotary Club Art Winners

Nursery Places

If your child was born between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 then they are eligible to **15 hours free** nursery provision per week.



Application forms for our school nursery can be obtained from the school office now.

Please note that nursery applications for our Nursery can no longer be completed on-line through the Staffordshire admissions website. They can only be made through the school directly.

We are able to offer the new 30 hours FREE childcare places for working parents of 3 and 4 year old children. Find out if you are eligible for the extra 15 hours of early education by applying online at the HMRC website:

If you require any help with an application, please feel free to speak to Mrs Wood in the school office.

Can I take this opportunity to remind you that we still offer Wraparound provision in our Nursery so that children can attend for full days if parents so wish if you do not qualify for the 30 free hours.

Afternoons £8 per session

Or £32 for a Full Week

If you, or someone you know, has a child that is eligible to join our Nursery, then please ensure you apply at the school office.
